

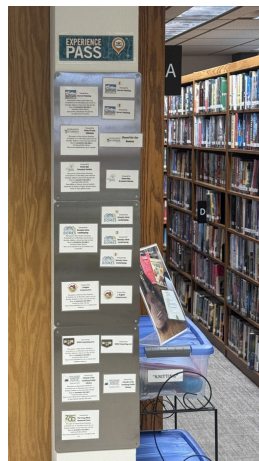

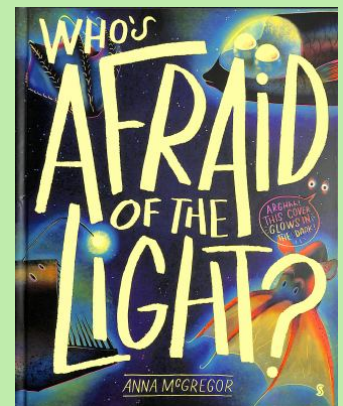
Updated 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program:

June 3, 2026: Summer Reading Registration

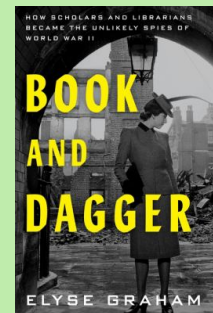
- First day of summer reading!

It's a Brat Fry and Bake Sale!

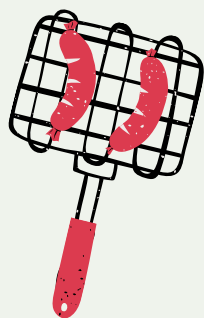

Do you like audiobooks? Don't like switching CD's? Have you tried using a Playaway?

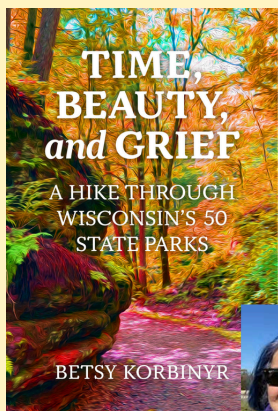
Playaway is the pre-loaded audiobook that gives everyone the portability and freedom to take audiobooks everywhere. No connectivity or downloads needed — ever.
